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## Profile

A competent, adaptable, and pro-active professional individual who is keen to learn, discover and challenge himself. During eight years of service with the British Royal Marines a high degree of professionalism, commitment and teamwork was demonstrated throughout. These experiences, alongside extra-curricular experiences have enabled skills transition, predominantly in self-employment, as an Activity Instructor, overseas Expedition Leader, Analyst and charity impact manager – all hugely rewarding roles.

Self-guiding a group of peers to the summit of Mont Blanc, completing the Reserve Forces Commando Course with the 'Determination Award' and completing Royal Marines Commando training with the 'Kingsbadge Award' after finishing top of the course of over 50 recruits.

**Combat Intelligence Analyst****(2014-2016)**

Selected as an analyst in the Intelligence Section at 30 Commando Information Exploitation Group RM, a unit designed to achieve information superiority, ensuring that Commanders have superior situational awareness. As a Combat Intelligence Analyst within the RM's responsibilities included management and conduct of all source and Open-Source research, generating products including briefs on enemy equipment, doctrine, tactics & intent, and analysis, processing & dissemination, including briefing and debriefing. Proactive in making short and long-term assessments on regional and world affairs and conducting training, supervising juniors, and running administrative routines accountable to senior officers under direction of senior non-commissioned officers.

**Combat Intelligence Analyst - Liaison Role****(2012-2014)**

Previous experiences earned passage to the privileged position of being attached to a sub-unit as the Intelligence Liaison Officer to the Surveillance and Reconnaissance Squadron. Providing critical intelligence gathering and dissemination to the SRS HQ and the HQs of higher formations, enabling the development of skills in cross organisation liaison. Additionally, completing the RM's Cold Weather Warfare Course in early 2013 during this position. Continued commitment to the RM's ethos and the desire to challenge learnt skills and represent the Corps was demonstrated during participation in both the ski and run elements of the RM 350 challenge, participating in the arduous Northern ski-leg in the Norwegian Arctic. The Northern ski-leg was particularly extreme and designed to challenge us as marines and raise funds for RM charities.

**Reconnaissance Operator (RO)****(2010-2012)**

Undoubtedly a high degree of fitness and robustness enabled application of learnt skills in challenging environments as a RO in the Royal Marines. Together, these experiences coupled with ground operations in Afghanistan proved robustness and commitment whilst on deployments. An operational tour during this role was one of the most dangerous and indeed successful; a great deal was learnt, gaining sound experience, emotional intelligence, and maturity as both a Marine and as an individual.
